**Why?** A compliment should refer to a specific part of the presentation that your peer did exceedingly well in.

**example of constructive criticism:** *A suggestion to improve your presentation is to look at the audience more.*

**NOT an example of a compliment:** *You were terrible at making eye contact with your audience.*

**Why?** Constructive Criticism is a helpful piece of advice that will help your peer improve his/her presentation next time. Simply criticizing will not provide room for improvement, nor is it considerate of feelings.
